29th July-7th August: U-15 Baseball World Cup @ Iwaki Green Stadium (Joban), Nambu Stadium (Nakoso) and Taira Baseball Stadium. Iwaki's first major international sports event is coming to Iwaki. 12 nations and regions including the host nation, Japan, will take part in over 50 matches during the weeklong tournament. 3rd-4th August: Iwaki Leg of the 1000km Relay to Tokyo @ route from Kaiseizan Athletics Track to Aquamarine Park. Although applications to run in the relay are closed, you can still help cheer on the runners along the Iwaki leg of the course. 6th August: Iwaki Fireworks Festival @ Aquamarine Park. From 7-8:30pm. The Iwaki Fireworks Festival is one of the largest fireworks festivals in the Tohoku Region, with over 20,000 individual fireworks arranged alongside music. This year is expected to be on an even larger scale to coincide with Iwaki City's 50th Anniversary celebrations. 6th-8th August: Taira Tanabata Festival @ Taira Shopping District. From 10am-9:30pm (until 9pm on the 8th August). The main shopping streets of Taira will be decorated with Tanabata decorations. 8th August: Iwaki Odori @ main street in front of Iwaki Station. From 4:25-8:40pm. The main leg of the Iwaki Odori attracts thousands of dancers and spectators, with people dancing along the main street in various groups. 9th August: Sumo Wrestling Summer Tour @ Iwaki City General Gymnasium, Taira. From 8am-3pm. To coincide with Iwaki's 50th Anniversary celebrations, there will be a Sumo Wrestling Tournament held in Iwaki. Ringside seating from ¥13,000-¥14,000. Pair seating from ¥20,000-¥24,000 for two people. Other seating including balcony and wheelchair seating from ¥4000-¥8000. Various seating conditions also apply. 13th-15th August: Iwaki Kaiten Yagura Bon Odori Festival @ area in front of Uchigo Station. From 1-9pm on the 13th, 4-9pm on the 14th and 5-9pm on the 15th August. Held every year during the Obon period in Uchigo, this festival features a giant rotating tower known as Kaiten Yagura and anyone is free to dance around the tower.
