### Limited services in Iwaki City Kyoritsu Hospital due to the opening of a new hospital



The Iwaki City Medical Centre will officially open on Christmas Day (25 Dec) and gradually take over the medical functions of the current Iwaki City Kyoritsu Hospital which is located nearby. To coincide with the opening, there will be limited outpatient treatment at Kyoritsu Hospital due to the transferring of medical equipment between 21-25 December. However, emergency patients will continue to be admitted as usual over this period.

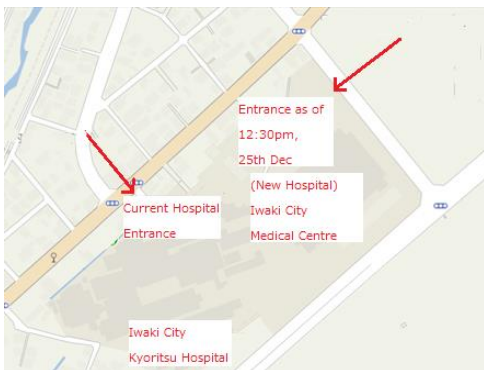
#### Iwaki Kyoritsu Hospital Schedule:

- 20 Dec:** Regular service
- 21-25 Dec:** Limited outpatient treatment (emergency treatments as usual)
- 26 Dec:** Beginning of outpatient treatment at the new Iwaki City Medical Centre
