Trial Run of Electric-Powered Transport in Onahama

Once again, a trial run of electric-powered transport known as Green Slow Mobility will be operating around the Onahama Port area. This time the low-speed transport will provide an expanded service, with a loop shuttle service stopping at 8 stops around the Aquamarine Park and AEON Mall area on weekends and public holidays and an on-demand service that can pick you up and drop you off at any of 20 different locations on weekdays.

Trial Period: 26 November – 8 March

Bus Times: 10:10am-3:55pm (weekends / public holidays);

10am-12pm & 1pm-4pm (weekdays)

Stops: Aquamarine Park, Aquamarine Fukushima, Iwaki La La Mew, AEON Mall Iwaki-Onahama, and several other stops

around the Onahama town centre.

Fee: ¥100

Capacity: Up to 9 passengers per ride On-Demand Service (weekdays only):

You can make a reservation for the Green Slow Mobility up to 3 operating days in advance or right before you want to ride. To reserve the transport, access the reservation site via the following link (https://bit.ly/iwakigs) or the QR Code below and input the where you want to get on/off as well as your phone number. You will then receive an SMS reply with a password which you can then use to check your reservation number and other details.





*You don't need to make a reservation to use the transport on weekends / public holidays
