The 9th Iwaki Sunshine Marathon

It is almost time again for the Iwaki Sunshine Marathon!

This year's event will be held on Sunday, 11 February. Up to 7,000 runners are expected to run in the 42.195km full marathon course, starting from Iwaki Athletics Stadium at 9am and finishing at Aquamarine Park. Thousands of runners will also take part in the 10km, 5km, 2km runs and 2km parent-child pair running events which will all start and finish at Aquamarine Park.

Apart from local citizens, many runners are expected to visit Iwaki from across the country. The marathon will also feature guest runners from Iwaki's various sister cities both domestic and abroad.

Although applications to run in the marathon are already closed, you are more than welcome to help the runners reach the finish line by joining some of the many spectators who will be cheering them along the way.

If you have any friends or family who are running in the marathon, there is a feature you can use on your smartphone or computer (*Ouen navi*) which allows you to track the progress of your runner on the course in real time.
