Conditions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Anyone who lives in Iwaki and who is either of foreign nationality, has non-Japanese ancestry (have a non-Japanese parent/relative etc.) or who were born/raised overseas may participate - There are two entry categories for the speech contest depending on how long you have lived in Japan - The speeches must be in Japanese - The speeches must not be longer than 5 minutes - The speeches can only be done individually (by 1 person only) - The drafts may be examined in advance if there are many applicants
Judgement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The winner will be decided by audience vote; it won't be judged on how well you speak Japanese but on the contents of the speech - The first placed winners of both categories will receive a certificate and ¥20,000 prize money - There will be other various prizes available and everyone will receive a prize for participation

Taking the JLPT test

The JLPT is just around the corner with the test to be held on 2 July. Those taking the test have probably spent months preparing for the test, whilst others may leave their study to cram in the last few days before the test day. Remember that you need to score a certain amount of points on the test overall AND score the required amount of points in each section (vocabulary/grammar, reading, listening) in order to pass.

For some last minute motivation, here are the points you need to aim for in order to pass each test level:
