<u>Lead-up Event for The 8th Pacific Islands Leaders Meeting</u> (PALM8)

There are just two months to go until Iwaki once again hosts the Pacific Islands Leaders Meeting or PALM Summit. The city will welcome leaders from 14 Pacific Island nations as well as the Prime Minister of Japan and foreign affairs ministers from Australia and New Zealand from 18-19 May. In the lead up to this international summit, Iwaki City will be holding an event in order to increase support among Iwaki residents for the event.

Date: Sunday, 4th March Time: 10:00am-4:00pm

Venue: Iwaki Green Base (21st Century Forest Park)

The lead-up event will include events suitable for all ages including booths introducing some of the participating nations, kids activities, quizzes about the Pacific nations, rugby and other sports workshops, and food stalls offering local Iwaki products and sweets. The first 300 entrants to the venue will receive a voucher which they can exchange for a small gift. Up to 200 participants will also have the chance to enter a quiz competition where they could win prizes including theme park tickets and domestic travel vouchers. On top of that, there will also be a stage featuring dance performances from various pacific countries including Samoa, Tonga and Fiji as well as hula, jangara and taiko drum performances.

This event will be a great chance to learn more about Japan's pacific neighbours and enjoy some of the culture of the nations that will be visiting Iwaki for the PALM8 summit in May.
