

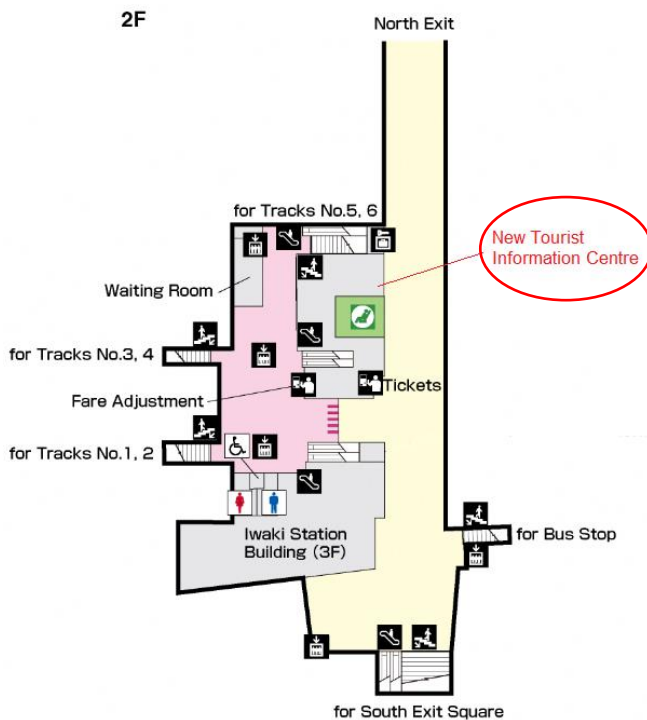

Opening of Newly-Built Tourist Information Centre at Iwaki Station

The Tourist Information Centre opened its new facility on 27 December 2019. The new centre offers more convenience, with a larger indoor space, pamphlets, displays of local specialty products touch-panel screen and free Wi-Fi internet. The centre is located next to the JR East ticket office inside Iwaki Station.



The facility is open all year (except New Year's Day) from 10am to 6pm.

Iceless Skate Rink Event at Spa Resort Hawaiians

To commemorate the upcoming 55th anniversary since the establishment of Spa Resort Hawaiians, an iceless skate rink will temporarily open in the facility. The skate rink will be surfaced with wax to produce a gliding effect similar to natural ice.

Fee	¥200 for 30 minute skating session *Fee includes helmet, knee protectors and insurance

In addition to skating on the iceless rink, you can also take part in a game with the Hawaiian's fire knife dancers from 3:00pm-3:35pm on weekends and public holidays during this event period (each game limited to 10 participants).

These types of iceless skate rinks are rare in Japan, so don't miss out on the opportunity to experience "Ice Skating in Hawaii".
