Onahama's New "Disaster-proof Shopping Mall" Opens This Month!

The area around Onahama Port has not only witnessed a significant amount of recovery from the Great East Japan Earthquake seven years ago, but the area has also seen a large amount of new development including the Marine Bridge, which opened last year, and a new shopping mall that will open this month.

The Aeon Mall Iwaki Onahama Store will hold its grand opening at 9am on Friday, 15 June. This new shopping mall is both a symbol of revitalisation for Iwaki and also serves an important function for disaster prevention. The mall will contain over 130 stores including major retail chains – some of which are opening their first stores in the prefecture or Tohoku – and a movie theatre.



Perhaps the most vital aspect of this development is how it has been designed as a temporary evacuation area in case of earthquakes or other natural disasters. A pedestrian bridge links the port area to the mall, allowing easy access for temporary evacuation. The first floor has been designed with pillars in order to withstand flooding from tsunamis.

Located along Onahama Port and within walking distance of Onahama Marine Bridge, Iwaki La La Mew and Aquamarine Fukushima, this new shopping mall will surely provide a wonderful addition to the already thriving Aquamarine Park area of Onahama Port.
