Bracing for the Fourth Wave

Iwaki has seen an extreme surge in COVID-19 cases over the past month, with numbers as high as 101 new cases in a day being recorded. In light of these outbreaks, it has been officially confirmed that the more-infectious Delta variant is now present in Iwaki. Although more beds and resources are being allocated, the strain that this is putting on Iwaki's medical system is not to be understated – as several of the non-severe cases are now quarantining in their own homes, as opposed to medical facilities.

To address this serious situation, Iwaki has once again entered a state of Simultaneous COVID-19 Countermeasures, effective until September 12th. Residents are advised to act in consideration of the safety of their friends and loved ones, and avoid non-urgent, non-essential outings as much as possible.

This is in addition to the standard measures, including refraining from travel, avoiding high-risk scenarios such as the "Three C's",, and practicing basic hygiene measures such as mask-wearing, not sharing plates, and careful washing a disinfecting of hands.

In light of the current circumstances, this month's issue of Iwa-Key will focus less on event information, in lieu of providing updates on Iwaki City's vaccine program, as well as other resources related to COVID-19.

Iwaki's COVID-19 Vaccination Process has resumed! Vaccine tickets for all lwaki residents over the age of twelve will be delivered, starting from September 3rd.

Upon receiving your ticket, please make a reservation using one of the below methods:

Enclosed with the ticket will be a Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire. Please complete it prior to vaccination. Although the original Japanese form must be filled out, an English translation is available for comparison via the link below*

When reserving vaccination, you will need to provide the 10-digit vaccination number listed on your tickets, name, and date of birth, as well as choose the date and the facility where you wish to be vaccinated.

For a full list of clinics offering vaccination, consult the enclosed list (however, please be advised that this list may vary according to vaccine supply). If you are uncertain of where to be vaccinated, mass vaccination sites such as Iwaki Greenbase and Iwaki Taira Gymnasium are a safe bet.
