Based on the concept of "Eat, See and Play in Iwaki", here you can immerse yourself in the vast and hilly outdoors. There are recreational facilities including a sports ground and tennis court. ## TONO AUTO CAMPING GROUNDS

Tono is an ideal venue not just for barbecuing but also provides all sorts of hands-on activities throughout the year including washi paper making. You can park your car and set up camp for an all-night feast under the stars.
