Plastic Containers and Packaging

To be collected once a week



Plastic containers and packaging for food products or daily goods with the recycling symbol on the left (except PET bottles).

Please separate items according to symbols on the left.

Cups, Trays, Containers

- Pudding or jelly cups
- Medicine packaging

Do not double bag.

- •Labels on PET bottles, etc.

How to put out plastic containers and packaging

- •Wash or wipe off the remaining food or dirt.
- •The lids and labels of PET bottles should be sorted as "Plastic Containers and Packaging."

Plastic goods/products (themselves) do not fall under this category and should be sorted as

"Plastic Products"

Bowls or buckets





Items of this category that cannot be easily cleaned should be sorted as

Burnable Rubbis

Wash containers as much as possible before putting them out.

Plastic Goods and **Products**

To be collected once every 6 weeks

Goods and products made of plastic such as buckets or washing basins.

Hard plastic products that do NOT have the recycling symbol on them. Limited to items of "less than 60cm in length and 10kg in weight."


How to put out plastic goods and products

- •Remove any dirt, sand etc.
- •Broken items are also accepted.
- •Items made of multiple materials (plastic & metals, etc.) should be sorted either as "Burnable Rubbish" or as "Small Household Appliances & Metallic Items".

The following items should be sorted as "Burnable Rubbish



Please make sure that you have correctly sorted the rubbish before bringing it in. Depending on circumstances relating to the content of the rubbish, vehicles, or the facility, it may not be possible to accept the rubbish. Industrial wastes will NOT be accepted in any case.

To be collected once every 6 weeks

- Remove all the batteries
- Knives, nails or needles should be put in a metallic item or wrapped in paper with "キケン" (dangerous) written on it.
- •Empty the cans for oil, otherwise remove the oil remaining in the items with cloth, etc. Please put out the dirty cloth as "Burnable Rubbish".
- •TVs, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators, freezers, and airconditioners should be collected by the home appliance retailers or disposed at the designated collecting places.
- •Personal computers should be taken to the manufacturers.
- •Microwaves, fan heaters, and gas stoves with grills are categorized as "Designated items of Large Items".

How to put out large items





Please purchase the necessary number of tickets for large rubbish disposal (Ogata Gomi Shushu Shori Tesuryo Nofu Ken) at convenience stores (7-Eleven, FamilyMart, Lawson) etc. where the top right sticker is displayed. Please write your name on the ticket and paste it on the large rubbish. Put the rubbish out at the designated disposal spot by 8:30am on the collection day (Collection will be done even on rainy days.)

*The tickets for large rubbish disposal are non-refundable. Please confirm the fee at the Disposal Center before making a purchase.






How to put out newspapers, cardboard boxes, magazines, and paper packaging

•Sort the rubbish as each of the 4

categories on the left, and cross-tie

each group of rubbish with strings.

The paper and cardboard collection or postponement will be decided on the morning of the scheduled collection day.

Collection may still go ahead if it rains in your area, or may still be cancelled if it is dry. The decision will be made based on the overall weather conditions in the city on the day. Therefore, when you put out paper and cardboard, please confirm via the following ways without judging by yourselves.

Information about the day's collection will be made available over the phone (automated phone system 256-6596) and posted on Iwaki City's official website (both PC and mobile versions) and the rubbish sorting app around 7:30am of the collection day.

If the collection is cancelled, it will be postponed to the same day of the following week. Collection will be confirmed in the morning on that day.

If the collection day is postponed for a second time, the collection day of that month will be cancelled. The next collection will be decided on the collection day of the following month in the same way.

Even when the weather suddenly changes, the decision to cancel or not will not be overturned.

Paper and cardboard will be collected in several batches by categories, so please do not put it out after 8:30am even if there are still rubbish left in the collecting area.

Please separate items according to symbols above.

Glass bottles

•Metal lids should be sorted as "Cans and PET bottles".



How to put out cans and PET bottles

- •Rinse the inside of the containers. •Remove all the remaining food etc. from the cans. •Put the cans and PET bottles in one rubbish bag. •Put the metal lids in the same rubbish bag as the cans and PET bottles.
- •Remove the lids and labels from PET bottles. •Put out the lids and labels of PET bottles with "Plastic Containers and Packaging". •Use up and empty the spray cans. (Unnecessary to pierce a hole in the can)
- •Please sort the cans of snacks, seaweed, or tea as "Small Household Appliances and Metallic Items."

How to put out glass bottles

•Rinse the inside of the bottles. •Put the glass bottles in a different rubbish bag from that for "Cans and PET Bottles". •Try to return the big Sake bottles or beer glass bottles to liquor shops. •Put out the metal lids with "Cans and PET Bottles." •Please sort any bottles containing fruit wine or perfume as "Unburnable Rubbish". •When you dispose of broken bottles, separate from non-broken ones and write "キケン" (dangerous) on the rubbish bag. (Do not wrap them with paper).



Burnable Rubbish

To be collected twice a week

- •Less than 60cm in length and 10kg in weight
- •Kitchen waste, raw garbage
- •Paper rubbish that cannot be sorted as "Paper & Cardboard"
- Clothes, textile products
- ●Wooden products/chunks, 60cm未満 tree branches

How to put out "Burnable Rubbish"

- Remove water and other liquid from the rubbish well. arpets or blankets should ound with strings and made less than 60cm in
- •Tree branches should be bound with strings and made less than 60cm in length and 20cm in diameter for "one bundle". (Up to 2 bundles) •Pet droppings should be wrapped in paper when disposing.



Do not forget!

How to put out used dry-cell batteries

Please put them in a transparent bag so that the batteries inside are visible. Button, rechargeable, or lithium-ion batteries will not be collected. Please dispose of



Unburnable Rubbish

To be collected once every 6 weeks

- •Less than 60cm in length and 10kg in weight
- •Glass products and light bulbs
- •Very dirty glass bottles
- Porcelains
- Lighters



How to put out "Unburnable Rubbish"

When you dispose of broken glass products (other than glass bottles), wrap them with paper and write "キケン" (dangerous) on them.



Non-collectable **Items**

City service will not collect the following items. Please contact the specialized disposal businesses for each item.

•Designated items according to the Home Appliance Recycling Act (TV, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators, and air conditioners) [should be taken to the home appliance retailers, or the following areas] *XDesignated disposal area/ Sanko ≥58-4308/

Personal computers (to the manufacturer)
 Motorbikes (to motorbike disposal businesses)

- Items difficult to be disposed: car parts, fire extinguishers, fire-proof saves, electric water boilers, tin drums, tires, batteries, building materials, bathtubs, bath water boilers, oil heaters, pianos, boilers, etc.
- Industrial wastes
- •Items of 180cm or over in length, or of 50kg or over in weight
- Dangerous items: gasoline, thinner, dangerous drugs, agrochemicals, gas cylinders, etc.
- Large amount of rubbish: those created due to moving, major house cleaning, tree pruning, etc.

● Each household may place two or less bags in the collecting area at one time. (Please note that if you put out a large amount of rubbish at one time, it will not be collected).

Use and Management of the Rubbish Collecting Areas

Separate and sort the rubbish into designated categories and put them out at the designated rubbish collecting area in the city-approved rubbish bags by 8:30am on the collecting day for each category.

- The area where you can put out your rubbish is the collecting area designated by the group of people who use the same collecting area together.
- Please do NOT put out the rubbish anywhere other than the designated collecting area.
- The following rubbish that is put out at the collecting area improperly will NOT be collected by the city service.

[Rubbish that does not follow the sorting rules, large items, designated items according to the Home Appliance Recycling Act (air-conditioners, TV, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators and freezers), personal computers, industrial wastes, a large amount of rubbish (from moving, tree branch/grass trimming) etc.]

NEW City Approved Plastic Rubbish Bag (Standards have changed)

When putting out the rubbish, please make sure to use the city-approved plastic bag either for rubbish from home or from businesses.

Rubbish from Home

- Length: The size of the bag doesn't matter as long as the capacity is between 15 liters and 45 liters.
- Color
 Colorless type. Translucent bags can be also used as long as contents are visible.
 However, bags with printed letters, marks or colored bags cannot be used.
- Shape : Both "bags with handles" and "bags without handles" can be used.

• Material: Made of polyethylene

• For items that won't fit inside 45 liters city-approved plastic bags, please write (or label) "ごみ" (rubbish) on it, (that will indicate your intent to dispose of the item as rubbish) ※ Items less than 60cm in length and 10kg in weight.

Rubbish from Businesses (other than home)

- For the rubbish from businesses (those other than from home), please make sure to use the special garbage bag for businesses (150yen per bag).
- 2 The bags can be purchased at convenience stores (Seven-eleven, Family Mart, Lawson) etc.
- * Please refer to the rules below regarding the rubbish from businesses...

Rubbish from Businesses (other than home)

Rubbish from business places is categorized as the "Rubbish from businesses" regardless of the kinds of rubbish or of the amount no matter how little it is, and should be disposed appropriately by the business operator in their own responsibilities.

Rubbish from businesses is categorized as (1) "Industrial wastes" and (2) "General rubbish from businesses (rubbish other than industrial wastes)".

In Iwaki City, only the (2) general rubbish (burnable rubbish) from businesses is accepted at the city facilities.

Please dispose the rubbish by any of the following methods.

- ① Consign the disposal of rubbish to the city-approved general rubbish collecting corporations.
- ② Take in the rubbish on your own to Nanbu Seiso (Rubbish Disposal) Center.
- ③ Dispose the rubbish at the collecting area for household rubbish using the special garbage bag for businesses.

*For businesses disposing of the general rubbish (burnable rubbish only), special garbage bags are required. They will be collected at the same area for household rubbish, however, please make sure to get approval from the manager of the collecting place in advance.



FAQ

- Q1 How can I distinguish between "Plastic Containers/Packaging" and "Plastic Goods/Products"?
- A1 "Items with 🔀 mark should be sorted as "plastic containers and packaging". Items without 🔀 should be sorted as "Plastic Goods and Products".
- Q2 Cans of snacks, tea, seaweed, or powder milk etc. can be sorted as "Metallic Items" or as "Cans"?
- A 2 Items without 😝 🛕 should be sorted as "Metallic Items" and items with 😝 🛕 should be sorted as "Cans".
- Q3 What should I do if the rubbish is not collected at the usual time?
- A3 Collection time may change depending on the amount of rubbish collected and road condition on the day. If rubbish weren't collected by around 4:00pm, please contact your nearest city branch offices by phone.
- Q4 How should I sort my rubbish?
- A4 You can check rubbish sorting by "Iwaki City AI Chatbot system" or rubbish sorting app "ThreeR (さんあーる). For more details, please contact your nearest city branch offices by phone.
