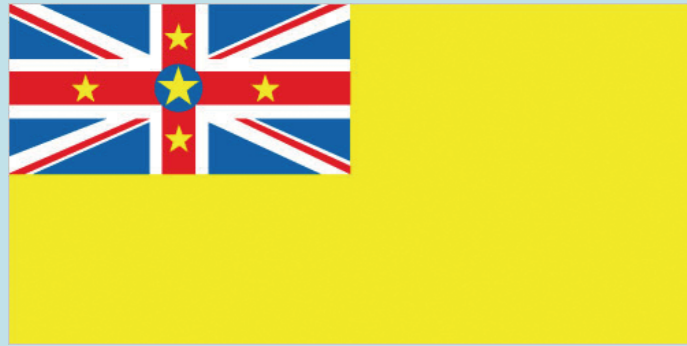

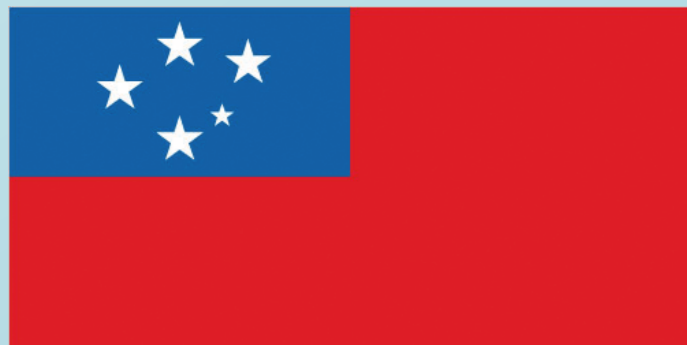
Niue

 Exports: Coconuts, Yam, Taro, Metals

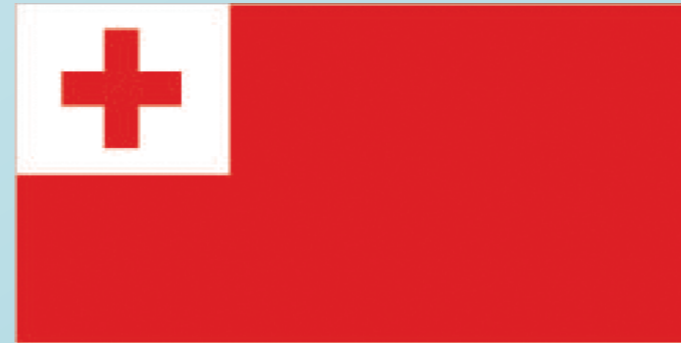
Samoa

Tonga



- Tonga is the only Pacific Island country that was never a colony and is also the only Pacific Nation with its own monarch (currently King Tupou VI)

 Language: Tongan, English

- Tuvalu is the second least populous independent state in the world after the Vatican City

 Population: 11,000 (13th)
 Capital: Funafuti
 Head of Government: Prime Minister
 Language: English, Tuvaluan
 Currency: Australian Dollar
